Week 1

What Are You Talking About?

Give your youth an opportunity to introduce themselves to one another. By the end of your group time they should know each others names and yours!
There are icebreaker ideas in the Try This! box.

Go over the That's a Good Question! sheet.
It's important that all youth participate in the My Thoughts segment by writing their own self-perception. They can be encouraged to share their responses with the group, but should not be required to.

Be sure that all of your youth have registered. If not, have them fill out a green card from your binder and give them a medical release form to take home to their parents.

Before you go take time to pray as a group. Your youth can use the Yeah God/Shout Out box to list their prayers.

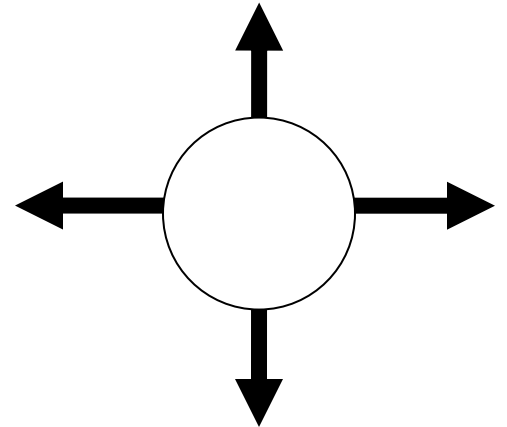
